

## Impact of the PE and Sports Premium Spend 2014 - 2015

St Matthew's Primary School received £9000 in PE and Sports Premium Funding 2014 – 2015.

### **Impact of PE and Sports Premium Spend**

#### **Dance Desk: Learning Community Support Consultancy**

DanceDesk has supported staff at St Matthew's C of E Primary School to develop their teaching, confidence and provision in PE. Impact of support has been improved teaching and learning, Improved attainment and achievement in lessons through staff confidence to deliver high quality PE lessons. DanceDesk has supported the PE Leader to create a new PE curriculum and skills ladder to support and challenge pupils in school through a fun, exciting and engaging curriculum.

Write Dance for Early Years and KS1 alongside whole school new approach to handwriting and cursive handwriting scheme has seen a rapid improvement in handwriting. EYFS have seen an impact in Physical Development and fine motor skills and hand-eye co-ordination.

#### **PE and Sport Equipment**

Resources purchased has allowed a higher level of differentiation to enable all children's needs to be met through appropriate challenge and support. Resources purchased have given pupils the opportunities to take part in a range of sports. Exciting resources has impacted behaviour, confidence and attainment in lessons.

#### **AfPE Quality Award**

St Matthew's have received the AfPE Quality Award for PE with Distinction. The award has raised the profile of physical education and sport at a local, regional and national level. The award process has supported planning monitoring and continuous development of high quality physical education and sport. AfPE have supported the school to identify next steps to continue to raise standards in PE and Sport for all pupils.

#### **Complete Kidz – After School Club**

Complete Kidz provided weekly after school lessons for pupils from Rec to Year 6 across the year. The lessons provided opportunities for pupils to take part in sports they may not otherwise have the opportunity to partake in. For example, trampoline lessons, skateboarding, fencing and archery. Pupils have thoroughly enjoyed the clubs and have developed confidence, stamina and passions for different activities. The clubs saw an increase in after school physical activity.

#### **Cluster Sports Events and Transport**

KS2 pupils took part in a cluster football tournament. This year parental and staff support increased and pupils completed the tournament at a higher position in the league to previous years. KS2 took part in the Great Big Dance Off reaching the finals. This has seen increased participation in after school clubs and development of skills.

#### **Supply to cover professional development (x2 days)**

PE Leader and PE specialist have attended professional development conferences and workshops to support the delivery of the new curriculum, assessment, planning and policies.

#### **Level 4 Learning Support Practitioner**

L4 specialist dance coach (L4) has been employed for the year to deliver physical education and sport. This has included team teaching, support for Newly Qualified Teachers, after school club provision and whole school staff training.
